Back to Business is an European Social Funded Project run by Central London Connexions to help young people aged 14-19 who are at risk of becoming NEET (Not in Employment, Education and/or Training) to stay in a job, apprenticeship or learning.

WHAT WILL I GET?

- **Extra help from a Project Worker** to help you achieve your goals and stay in learning, training or work
- **Short accredited courses to gain qualifications in a wide range of areas including:**
 - Multimedia ■ Sports ■ Beauty
 - Retail ■ Construction**and personal development courses including:**
 - First Aid ■ Residentials ■ Goals
 - Get on Track personal development course with professional athletes.
- **Access to hardship funds** to help you buy things you may need at school, college, training or apprenticeship
- **Rewards such as £50** worth of vouchers when you stay in work, school, college, training or apprenticeships for one term and **another £50** for staying in two terms.

Around 7 months
