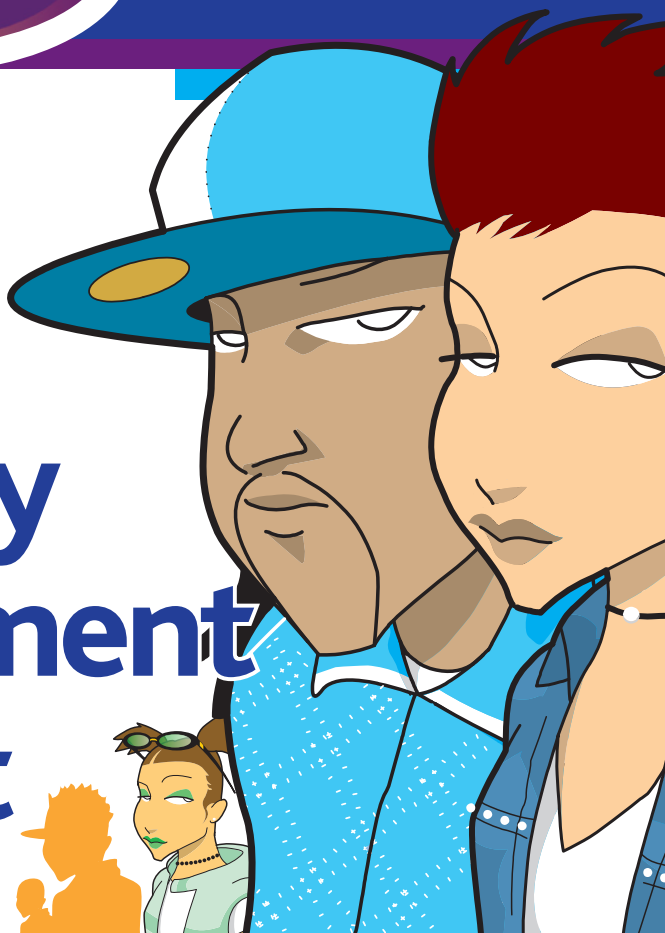

Activity Agreement Pilot Project

Central London Connexions (CLC) has been running one of eight national Activity Agreement pilots (AAP) from April 2008 which helps 16 and 17 year-olds who are NEET (Not in Employment, Education or Training) get into EET (Employment, Education or Training).

How is the project delivered?

Personal Advisers (PAs) in central London deliver the project to 570 young people each year.

Who can join the project?

- 16 or 17 year-olds (over compulsory school age) who are NEET.

N.B.: If the young person is in receipt of benefits please check with the AAP PA for eligibility.

How long do they have to be NEET?

- At least 13 weeks or
- At least 5 weeks and belong to a **vulnerable group**. These young people should have worked with another professional for at least 5 weeks.

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How does the project help young people?

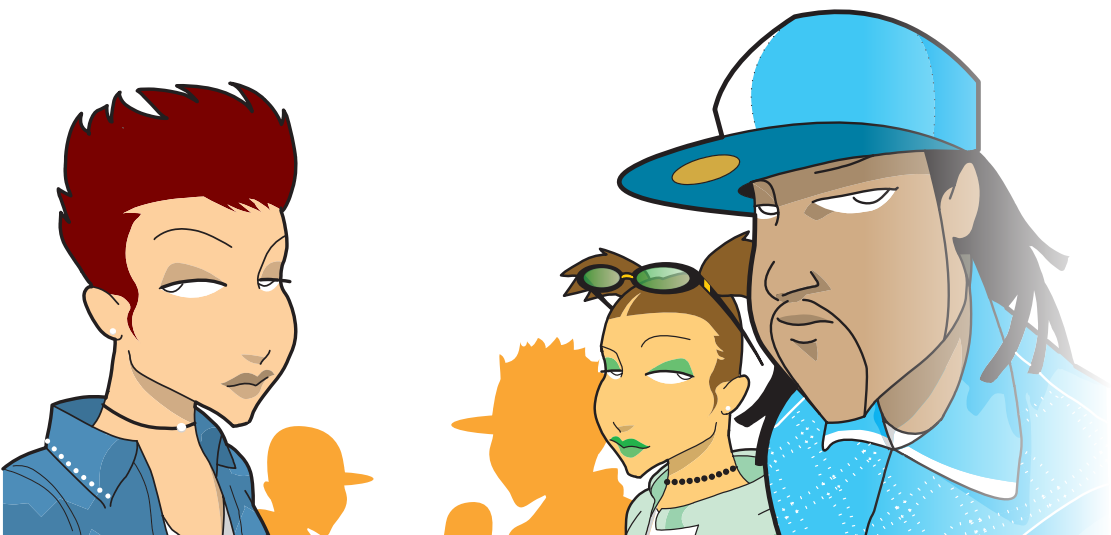
- **One-to-one support** - A personally negotiated contract between the PA and young person, identifying specific steps they should take to move into education, training or employment.
- **Tailor-made activities** - For example, First Aid Training, Job Readiness, Literacy and Numeracy, Work Experience, Retail, Youth Work and much, much more...
- **Weekly allowance of £30 for up to 20 weeks** - In return for proven engagement in the steps and activities agreed in the contract.
- **Financial support** - Help with other costs including travel, lunch, courses, enrolment and interview clothes.

What types of young people belong to a vulnerable group?

- Carers (own child or other person)
- Gypsy, Roma or Traveller
- Homeless
- Looked After / In Care / Care Leavers
- Substance Misusers
- Supervised by Youth Offending Service
- Refugees or Asylum Seekers who have been granted Refugee Status, Indefinite Leave to Remain, or Humanitarian Protection
- Young people who have Learning Difficulties/Disabilities
