

Update to ALDCS: November 2008

Who is using LCCIS

LCCIS is now part of the daily work of Connexions PAs and Managers:

- Finding local residents who have travelled out of the area to learn
- To mass-update files for young people showing as NEET or Not Known when more recent information is posted elsewhere
- To plan support for young people by numbers in each ward
- To analyse where young people NEET were last in learning
- To know when a local resident young person NEET is infact in learning in another area

Since June 2008 384 users have accessed the system 2,236 times.

Data reports

A comprehensive range of reports are already available on LCCIS, with more in the pipeline.

All London CCIS users can now access the following data reports posted on the LCCUS web-based report runner:

Reports now available:

2009 Leavers by borough (shows no. of residents within borough selected and is grouped by statutory school borough, statutory school name and then by ward of residency)

2009 Leavers by ward (shows same as above i.e. residents by chosen borough but grouped by resident ward, stat school borough and then stat school name)

NEET 2008 Leavers (shows residents for borough selected and is grouped by ward, statutory school borough and then previous statutory school name including out of borough/area schools)

LCCIS Hits for the selected period and borough/sub-region)

Reports coming soon:

NEET matches on CCIS – showing where a young person NEET is infact in learning in another borough

Year 11 transition update (shows young people for whom a more up-to-date destination exists on LCCIS than is currently shown - e.g. current record shows NEET, more up to date record elsewhere shows EET)

How to run the reports for your borough

- Log into LCCIS website: <https://lccis.co.uk>
- If you do not have a password, ask your sub-regional CCIS unit for one
- Click on Reports on left-hand side listed under Site Navigation
- Click on report name e.g. 2009 leavers by borough
- Select the borough or sub region as appropriate for the results you wish to view

Local Authority data partners and other senior staff are welcome to make appropriate use of LCCIS. If you wish to access LCCIS reports and are not a CCIS user, please ask your sub-region how access can be arranged for you.

Further developments

Full integration will shortly provide 3 x daily updates to the data held on the 5 sub-regional CCIS data bases, triggered by PA verification of the change of status (or personal information) of a client following LCCIS notification. This will radically improve data integrity, particularly for EET, NEET and Not Known status, and will further reduce the need for follow-up activity.

Integrated Youth Support Data

Discussions are underway with Career Vision, suppliers of CCIS in London, to update Connexions data in 2009 to provide the new Core IYSS data base.

This will be fully CCIS Compliant and will meet the needs of Integrated Youth Support Services, incorporating EYS data functions, and linking where needed to other data bases.
