

# SPEAR Course Information–Kensington & Chelsea

## ● What is SPEAR?

SPEAR is an employment preparation course for young people, run by the 'St Paul's Centre' in Hammersmith (registered charity number: 1100885).

## ● Who is aimed at?

16 -24 year olds who are:

- currently unemployed
- ready to get *serious* about finding a career that can satisfy them long term

## ● Are there any entry requirements?

Enrolling students must:

- express a desire to make changes in their life
- have the time to commit to the course and take it seriously
- have a good level of spoken English (able to participate in class discussions)
- NOT be on the governments 'New Deal' programme

## ● How long is the course?

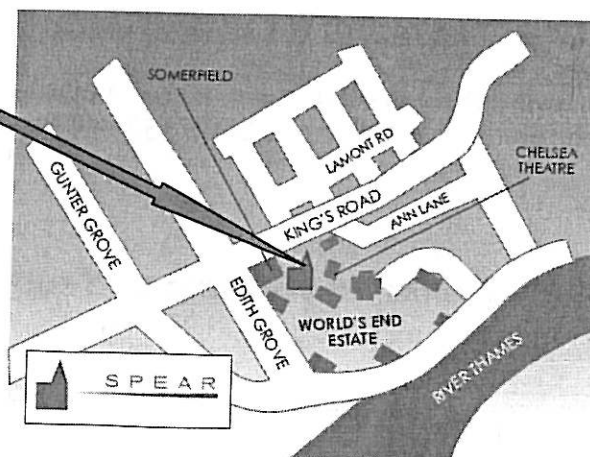
- SPEAR runs between **2-5pm Monday – Friday**
- Includes 3 modules: '**SPEAR Life**' (2 weeks), '**SPEAR Career**' (2 weeks), '**SPEAR Advance**' (2 weeks ).

## ● When does the next course start?

- **Monday 14th September 2009 at 2pm.**
- This first day is an '**Introductory Session**' where students can find out more about the course, and then decide if they want to enroll.
- The course begins on the following day at 2pm.

## ● Where is the course held?

## ● What's involved in the course?

### Module 1 – 'SPEAR Life' (2 weeks)

- Confidence & Motivation development
- Communication and Presenting techniques
- Team work

### Module 2 – 'SPEAR Career' (2 weeks)

- Help with CV writing & interview skills
- Career planning and job search training

### Module 3 – 'SPEAR Advance': Optional Qualification (2 weeks)

- 1) Level 1 VRQ in Customer Service accredited through the 'Hospitality Awarding Body' (3 days)
- 2) Level 1 VRQ in Selling accredited through the 'Hospitality Awarding Body' (3 days)

### PLUS...

#### Personal Coaching

Students are offered one-to-one coaching with a volunteer mentor for up to 6 months after the course finishes, to help them pursue their chosen career.

#### Work Experience

One week unpaid work experience placements within a London company are offered to graduating students who have demonstrated reliability and a positive attitude.

## ● How is the course assessed?

The Customer Service and Selling Qualifications both involve a one hour true/false style test at the end of the course

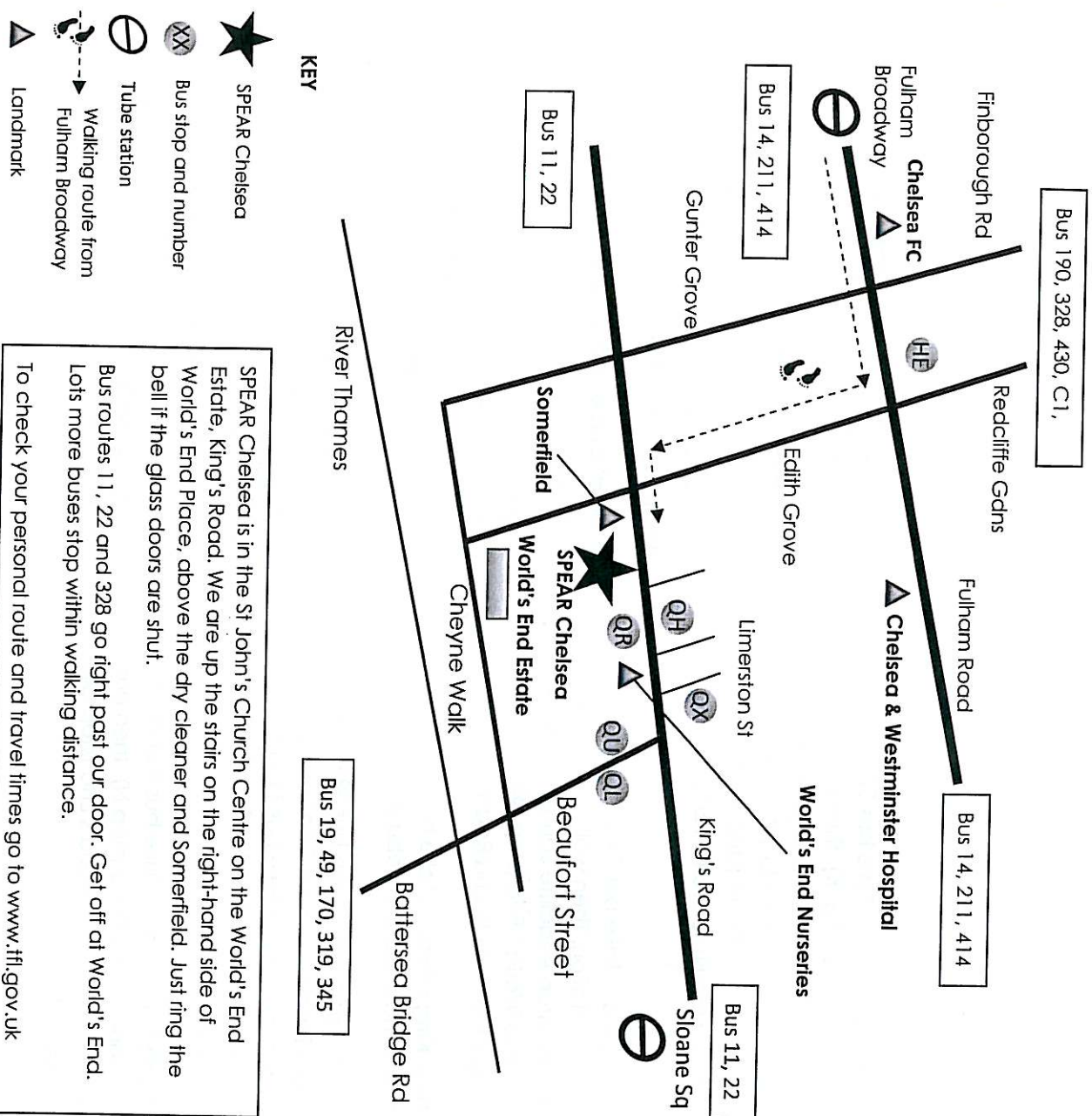
## ● How do I refer students to SPEAR?

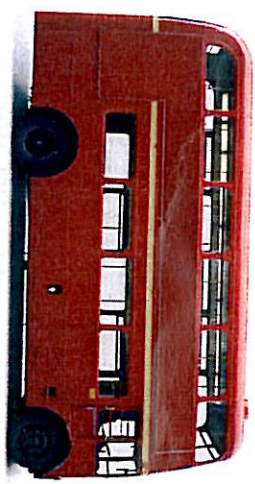
Bus routes 11, 22 and 328 go right past our door. Get off at World's End. Lots more buses stop within walking distance.

## I live in... how do I get to SPEAR Chelsea?

- ...**Earl's Court**... Take bus 328 to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Fulham Broadway**... Roughly a 20-minute walk or take bus 11 (from stop R on Harwood Road). Get off at World's End (stop QH, Hobury Street)
- ...**Fulham Cross**... Take bus 211 to Edith Grove (stop HE). Walk down Edith Grove to World's End
- ...**Fulham Road**... Take bus 14 or 414 to Edith Grove (stop HE). Walk down Edith Grove to World's End
- ...**Hammersmith**... Take bus 211 to Edith Grove (stop HE). Walk down Edith Grove to World's End
- ...**Holland Park**... Take bus 31 to Notting Hill Gate (stop B, Pembroke Road), then bus 328 (from stop C, across the road) to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Kensington High St**... Take bus 328 to World's End (stop QX, Limerston St)
- ...**Ladbroke Grove**... Take bus 52 or 452 to Notting Hill Gate (stop K), then bus 328 (from stop K) to World's End (stop QH, Hobury Street). Or take bus 7 or 70 to Westbourne Park Road (stop N), then bus 328 (from stop N) to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Lillie Road**... Take bus 74 or 430 to West Brompton station. Then walk to Redcliffe Gardens (stop Redcliffe Square) and take bus 328 to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street). Or see North End Road
- ...**New King's Road**... Take bus 22 to World's End (stop QH, Hobury Street)
- ...**North End Road**... Take bus 28 or 391 to Fulham Broadway (stop S on Harwood Road), then walk or take bus 11 (from stop R on Harwood Road) to World's End (stop QH, Hobury Street)
- ...**North Kensington**... Take bus 7 or 70 to Westbourne Park Road (stop N), then bus 328 (from stop N) to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Notting Hill**... Take bus 328 to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Shepherd's Bush**... Take bus 94 to Notting Hill Gate (stop M), then bus 328 (from stop K, across the road in Palace Gardens Terrace) to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**Westbourne Park**... Take bus 328 to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
- ...**West Kensington**... Take bus 28 or 391 to Fulham Broadway (stop S on Harwood Road), then walk or take bus 11 (from stop R on Harwood Road) to World's End (stop QH, Hobury Street)
- ...**White City**... Take bus 49 to King's Road/Beaufort Street (stop QL), then walk left along King's Road to World's End. Or take bus C1 to Earls Court Road/Old Brompton Road (stop L), then bus 328 from Redcliffe Gardens (stop Redcliffe Sq) to World's End (stop QX, Limerston Street)
